Mission Statement

The International Christian Academy of Nagoya is a Christ-centered school that impacts the world by providing students with an education based on a biblical worldview in an environment of academic excellence, while cultivating respect for people of all cultures and religions.

Accreditation

Since 2007, the Association of Christian Schools International (ACSI) and the Western Association of Schools and Colleges (WASC) have accredited the International Christian Academy of Nagoya (ICAN).

History & Description

During the 1999-2000 school year, the school became part of the Network of International Christian Schools (NICS), and the name was changed to International Christian Academy of Nagoya (ICAN). From 2001 to 2010, ICAN operated as a NICS school under the local auspices of Mission to the World. In May 2010, ICAN was recognized as a special foundation and now has its own hojin. The school exists to provide an English curriculum based on a Christian philosophy to international and Japanese students. The International Christian Academy of Nagoya is a private, coeducational day school, offering an American college preparatory curriculum to the international community in Nagoya. Ten countries are represented in the student body.

In grades 9 through 12, one credit is awarded for each one-year course successfully completed and one-half credit for one semester. A minimum of 25 credits is required for a College Prep diploma. Students must complete 20 hours of community service each year.
