WHO WE ARE AT ICAN

- ICAN is a college preparatory, K5-12th grade, English speaking, International school that prepares students primarily to study in America, other English speaking universities and foreign universities with English programs.
- ICAN is accredited with **WASC** and **ACSI** through June 30th, 2021.
- ICAN belongs to the network of NICS/Oasis and is one of 17 schools in 15 countries.
- ICAN has an **AP-based (Advanced Placement)** “American” curriculum, which intentionally includes **AEROS** International standards.
- ICAN offers **AP courses through Northstar Academy our online curriculum:** AP English Language & Composition, AP English Literature & Composition, AP U.S. History, AP European History, AP World History, AP Calculus AB, AP Calculus BC, AP Chemistry and AP Biology.
- ICAN is a member of **ACSI (Association of Christian Schools International)**.
- ICAN has **15 paid staff**; 12 of whom are expatriate from NICS (native English speakers)
- **100%** of our faculty are **fully licensed teachers** with certificates from outside Japan.
- **ICAN director has a doctorate and 8 (73%) out of 11 teachers have master’s degrees.**
- ICAN has **85 full-time students enrolled from 17 countries.** Of those, **50% are Japanese** and **50% are foreigners.**
- ICAN uses the **MAP test for standardized testing** and it is given to all students 3 times a year to track academic progress.
- ICAN is focused on teaching **the "whole student"** in partnership with the parents.
- ICAN offers specials' classes in **Music and Physical Education.**
- ICAN has a "**Spiritual Emphasis Week**". Many other events rotate through the calendar including **PTF Festival, Sports Day, Christmas Program, etc.**
- ICAN has a traditional schedule for elementary and secondary.
- ICAN uses Gradebook Wizard to report cards for students in grades 3-12.
